*California* 59  
Pauline Lhote has had a lifelong love affair with Champagne and sparkling wines. Growing up in the Champagne region of France she fostered this interest and directed her higher education toward attaining the expertise to accomplish the goal of producing these glorious wines.
- 30** **Veuve Clicquot Brut Yellow Label, Gaele Goossens**  
*Champagne, France* 115  
Goossens is redefining the industry to show women at the forefront while always honoring Madame Clicquot's pioneering spirit. She holds degrees in Biochemistry and Oenology from the Universite de Reims in Champagne. Joining the Veuve Clicquot team in 2016 she has quickly cemented herself as a face of the brand.

### White Wines

- 210** **Crios Winery Torrontes, Susana Balbo**  
*Cafayete/Uco, Argentina* 46  
In 1999, with almost two decades dedicating her talent to the wine business working as a consultant, Susana Balbo decided to make her dream of having a winery of her own come true and put down roots in the heart of Luján de Cuyo Mendoza.
- 887** **Gran Moraine Chardonnay, Eugenia Keegan**  
*Yamhill-Carlton, Oregon* 97  
Keegan has been a force behind Jackson Family Wines' success in Oregon since she joined the company in 2014. She oversees the winemaking for Gran Moraine, Zena Crown, WillaKenzie Estate, Penner-Ash Wine Cellars, and the Willamette Valley programs for Siduri and La Crema.
- 171** **Cakebread Sauvignon Blanc, Stephanie Jacobs**  
*Napa Valley, California* 78  
Stephanie joined Cakebread Cellars in 2004 as the Enologist and was promoted to Assistant Winemaker in 2008. She was appointed Cakebread Cellars' Winemaker in 2017, becoming only the fourth winemaker in the winery's 40+ year history. Stephanie first became interested in wine while participating in an exchange program in France. She decided to turn this passion into a profession while studying at the University of California at Davis. Upon graduation, she began her winemaking career working at a small winery in the Sierra Foothills, learning about cellar operations and lab analysis. Stephanie is active in the Napa Valley Wine Technical Group.
- 301** **Far Niente Chardonnay, Nicole Marchesi**  
*Napa Valley, California* 117  
A graduate of the Viticulture and Enology program at The University of California at Davis, Nicole honed her skills in Sonoma and New Zealand before coming to Far Niente as an Enologist in 2005. She was soon promoted to Assistant Winemaker, and four years later became the fourth Winemaker in Far Niente's 30-year history. During her tenure, Marchesi has gained a deep understanding of Far Niente's estate vineyards, working with the sites and individual blocks to bring forth the discrete character of each. Ultimately, Marchesi strives to create wines of elegance and depth that capture both place and vintage, while staying true to the Far Niente house style.

- 888** **Honig Sauvignon Blanc, Ashley Egelhoff**  
*Napa Valley, California* 63  
A graduate of the Viticulture and Enology program at The University of California at Davis, Ashley polished her winemaking skills at Joseph Phelps Vineyards. She then spent some time working in Mendoza, Argentina before joining the Honig team in 2012 as an Enologist. She was then promoted to Assistant Winemaker and is now the Winemaker for Honig Sauvignon Blanc.

### Red Wines

- 551** **FEL Pinot Noir, Sarah Green**  
*Anderson Valley, California* 87  
An English major who grew up with a love of literature, Sarah feels a literary connection to winemaking; every wine and vineyard has both content and style, its own language and narrative. Born and raised in Southern California, Sarah earned a degree in English from Smith College in 2011. She then worked at wineries in the Sonoma Coast, New Zealand, and Australia, learning different styles of winemaking. In 2017, Sarah joined the team at FEL Wines and was promoted to Head Winemaker in 2021.
- 537** **Gran Moraine "Yamhill-Carlton" Pinot Noir, Eugenia Keegan**  
*Yamhill Carlton, Oregon* 92  
Born fifth generation to a family with deep roots in the Russian River Valley, Eugenia began her career with Joseph Swan Vineyards in 1976. She then headed to France, where she worked harvests in Burgundy and Puligny-Montrachet. Upon returning to California in 1982, she held a series of Executive positions and also established her own label, Keegan Cellars, specializing in single-vineyard Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. After relocating to Oregon, Eugenia served as general manager of The Four Graces before joining Gran Moraine, first as a Consultant. She was named Gran Moraine winemaker in 2014, and then pivoted to a new role in 2016 as General Manager. Eugenia also plays an essential role in the Willamette Valley and larger Oregon wine community and has served as Chair of the Board of Directors of the Oregon Wine Board, President of the Oregon Winegrowers Association, President of the Willamette Valley Wineries Association Board, and Co-Chair of Willamette: The Pinot Noir Auction.
- 775** **Robert Mondavi Cabernet Sauvignon, Geneviève Janssens**  
*Napa, California* 59  
Janssens has held the well-respected positions of Director of Production at Opus One, Director of Winemaking at Robert Mondavi Winery and now Chief Winemaker. In 2010, she was named Wine Enthusiast's Winemaker of the Year.
- 780** **Jordan Vineyards Cabernet Sauvignon, Maggie Kruse**  
*Sonoma, California* 98  
Maggie Kruse grew up in a home where wine was always on the table, and dinner conversations often involved the science of fermentation. She joined Jordan Winery as an enologist in 2006, and moved her way up to head winemaker in 2019.
- 805** **Joseph Phelps Cabernet Sauvignon, Ashley Hepworth**  
*Napa, California* 149  
Ashley's approach to winemaking is deceptively simple: let the vineyards and vintages speak for themselves. Said simply, "Our estate vineyards give such quality and purity of fruit and there's a consistency to our wines, not because of a recipe, it's because the vineyards are so solid."

**880 Duckhorn ‘Paraduxx’, Renée Ary**  
*Napa, California* 78  
 Renée Ary was promoted to winemaker for Duckhorn Vineyards in 2014 after spending 11 years honing her craft, refining her gifted palate, and mastering the Duckhorn Vineyards style. Her approach balances artistry, science, and a deep respect for the viticultural side of winemaking.

**885 Amuse Bouche, Heidi Peterson Barrett**  
*Napa, California* 279  
 In 1988, Heidi Peterson Barrett became a freelance winemaker, making wine for a number of small wineries including Amuse Bouche and Dalla Valle Vineyards, where she created some powerful Cabernets, including the famous “Maya” cult wine, which received two perfect 100 point scores from Robert Parker.

**889 Freemark Abbey Merlot, Kristy Melton**  
*Napa, California* 97  
 Originally trained as a Biologist, Kristy Melton made a fortuitous switch to winemaking in 2007. Honored to be named among Wine Enthusiast magazine’s “Top 40 under 40 Taste-Makers,” as well as Drinks Business’ “Top 30 under 40 Winemakers to Watch,” Melton leverages her meticulous attention to detail to craft wines of structure, finesse, and balance.

**155 Feudi di San Gregorio Greco di Tufo**  
*Campania, Italy* 53  
 Feudi di San Gregorio, has obtained a 2021 Equalitas Corporate certification regarding wine sustainability. This certification was created by a group of stakeholders with a shared approach to build on social, environmental, and economic pillars.

**535 Sokol Blosser Dundee Hills Pinot Noir**  
*Willamette, Oregon* 59  
 Being good stewards of the land to leave it in as good or better shape for the next generation is a key part of being sustainable at Sokol Blosser

**695 Ferrari-Carano Merlot**  
*Sonoma, California* 63  
 CSWA certified sustainable since 2015 and awarded Sustainable Producer/Maker of the Year at the 2019 Sonoma County Harvest Fair. The winery, located in Sonoma County’s Dry Creek Valley, has been practicing sustainable winegrowing practices for years and was the first winery to release wines bearing the ‘Sonoma County Sustainably Farmed Grapes’ label.

**746 Gérard Bertrand Prima Naturae Cabernet Sauvignon**  
*Languedoc, France* 46  
 Naturae is a range of wine made without added sulfites which offers particularly pure, generous, and intense aromas. This wine is born from the knowledge of Gérard Bertrand and his enologists, who have a unique expertise in sulfites-free winemaking. The wines are grown according to organic standards and are also vegan.

**815 Zolo Mendoza Malbec**  
*Mendoza, Argentina* 46  
 Made with grapes from the first zone from the Mendoza River Valley, this wine has a marked fruitiness, while spending eight months in oak. The winery seeks to reflect the best expression of the terroir, through sustainable development practices that preserve the environment in the best way.

**686 Markham Merlot**  
*Napa Valley, California* 74  
 Markham’s 260 acres of sustainably farmed estate vineyards allow the viticulture and wine making team to showcase the diverse characteristics of this world-class growing region.

**891 Hacienda Araucano Cabernet Franc**  
*Lolol Valley, Chile* 46  
 After research in several regions of Chile, François Lurton planted his vineyard on virgin terroir, with poor soil and a healthy, balanced climate: the Lolol Valley. Drawing on his expertise and using environmentally friendly (biodynamic) methods, he has produced remarkable wines.
