CHAMPAGNE

Taittinger 'Prelude' Grand Crus Brut NV Champagne, France 183
Composed of 50% Chardonnay and 50% Pinot Noir selected exclusively from the top Grand Crus vineyards classified as '100%' in the Champagne system.

WHITE WINE

Bouchard Pere & Fils Chevalier-Montrachet Grand Cru 2013 Burgundy, France 932
Deep, smoky, soil-driven aromas of pineapple, nectarine, peach and clove. More musclebound and Montrachet-like than the "regular" Chevalier-Montrachet despite possessing lower acidity. Finishes very long and firm, with enticing notes of orange, gingerbread and honey.

Chateau D'Yquem 375ml 2019 Bordeaux, France 410
A juicy Yquem with tarte tartin, salted caramel and dried oranges on the nose and palate. Medium-to full-bodied and medium-sweet, with a creamy and round texture. The 2019 vintage has the highest proportion (45%) of Sauvignon Blanc in any modern Yquem.

RED WINE

Verite 'La Muse' 2019 Sonoma, CA 649
A blend of 90% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Franc and 5% Malbec. This wine shimmers with a deep violet-ruby core of color, expressing opulent fruit aromas of candied red & black cherry and wild fresh blackberry. Perfumed notes of dried potpourri and rosemary, with essences of sandalwood, cinnamon, nutmeg and clove from French oak aging.

Cakebread 'Dancing Bear Ranch' Cabernet Sauvignon 2014 Napa, CA 260
Sourced from 24 separate blocks of the Dancing Bear Ranch Estate on Howell Mountain, Cakebread's most exclusive vineyard. Once the wine opens up it releases aromas of dark cherries and currants, woven together with mocha, violets, anise and hints of peppery spices.

Pahlmeyer Proprietary Red Blend 2018 Napa, CA 280
Composed of 88% Cabernet Sauvignon, 11% Merlot and 1% Cabernet Franc. Blackberries and wild berries on the nose with hints of incense and ink, following through to a full body with super integrated tannins and a long, linear finish. It is structured, yet so polished and integrated, the tannins spreading beautifully across the palate. Caressing, like silk.

Harlan Estate Proprietary Red Wine 2018 Napa, CA 2,850
Stunning on every level, this wine reveals a dense purple hue as well as an incredible bouquet of crème de cassis, graphite, crushed stone, violets and tobacco. This wine is pure gold in Napa Valley.

Harlan Estate Cabernet Sauvignon 2017 Napa, CA 2,160
This wine is fully loaded, with waves of dense blackberry, black currant and fig, pulling roasted apple wood, bay leaf and espresso cream along. A bolt of cast iron emerges through the finish, remaining well-encased in the fruit.

Bond 'St. Eden' Red Blend 2017 Oakville, CA 1,450
This Cabernet Sauvignon based red blend is silky, soft and refined, with a gorgeous sense of purity to the fruits. Currants, blackberries and flowers on the nose. Beautiful, ripe fruit with compact tannins. The freshness and brightness are magnificent.

Screaming Eagle Cabernet Sauvignon 2020 Oakville, CA 7,200
Untouched by smoke taint, as the fruit was harvested early, the 2020 vintage is one of the great surprises from that year. Energetic and vibrant, this wine offers a bit more freshness than previous vintages. A cult classic.

Sine Qua Non 'Profuga' Grenache 2018 Santa Barbara, CA 1,490
78% Grenache, the balance composed of Mourvèdre, Syrah and Petite Sirah. The is a rich, heady wine. Black cherry, chocolate, new leather, spice and scorched earth give the 2018 its distinctly dark, brooding personality.

Domaine de la Romanee-Conti 2017 Burgundy, France 9,500
'Romanee St. Vivant' Grand Cru
This is a dramatic, head-turning Romanee-St. Vivant, soaring from the glass with scents of cassis, violets, blood orange, cinnamon and espresso. This wine is an exercise in lace and grace, though not without plenty of punch.

<p>Chateau Cheval Blanc Red Blend 2020 Intense and indelible, with layer upon layer of blueberry, raspberry, pomegranate, fennel, espresso and crushed rocks; just so much character and poise. The driest year at Cheval Blanc since 1959, with 71% of production from the entire estate going into this wine.</p>	Bordeaux, France	1,360
<p>Chateau Haut Brion 2018 Composed of 49% Merlot, 39% Cabernet Sauvignon and 12% Cabernet Franc, the wine has a dark, intense red color. The initial impression on the nose is deep, spicy, and incredibly complex, underscored by ripe black fruit aromas. It starts out soft and well-structured on the palate, becoming full-bodied with impressive volume and smooth tannin. The finish is incredibly long, enhanced by rich flavors that are neither heavy nor harsh.</p>	Bordeaux, France	1,410
<p>Chateau Margaux 2017 89% Cabernet Sauvignon, with the balance comprised of Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Petite Verdot. Medium-bodied, the elegance and finesse on the palate is simply bedazzling, exuding a quiet intensity of fresh black fruits layered with oh-so-subtle floral and earth nuances. It has a soft, velvety texture and seamless freshness to support the tightly wound flavors, finishing long and perfumed.</p>	Bordeaux, France	1,220
<p>Chateau Lafite Rothschild 2019 Composed of 94% Cabernet Sauvignon, with a little bit of Merlot and Petite Verdot. An opulent and fruit-forward vintage for Lafite in 2019. Vivid purple color in the glass with blackcurrant, cherry, and milk chocolate notes. Gorgeous weight on the palate with fine tannins and depth of flavor. Not so much rich but driven, refined and elegant, almost refrained.</p>	Bordeaux, France	1,650
<p>Biondi Santi 'Tenuta Greppo' Brunello di Montalcino 2015 This 2015 vintage is dark, exuberant and bold, but also precise, focused and sharp. The wine shows blackberry, dried cherry, plum and dark cassis. Those dark fruit tones segue to a rich presentation of tar, spice, earth, tobacco and sweet balsam herb.</p>	Tuscany, Italy	890
<p>Solaia 2020 Only produced in exceptional years, this wine is made up of mostly Cabernet Sauvignon, with some Sangiovese and Cabernet Franc. A deep ruby red color. Impressive on the nose for its aromatic complexity and finesse. Notes of small red fruit, especially raspberries and mulberries, lead to sweet sensations of ripe apricots and red oranges together with light floral hints of roses. Distinct aromas of coffee beans, chocolate and licorice are perfectly integrated and are accompanied by fresh impressions of mint and white pepper.</p>	Tuscany, Italy	370
<p>Masseto 2016 100% Merlot. The 2016 is the second vintage in a row to score 100 points. A thunderstorm of emotions, yet it manages to keep them perfectly under control. Delicate and graceful, yet rich and powerful. Iconic!</p>	Bolgheri, Italy	1,352
<p>Ornellaia Bolgheri Superiore 2019 A blend of 62% Cabernet Sauvignon, 31% Merlot, 4% Petit Verdot and 3% Cabernet Franc. An intense ruby-red color, with a bouquet full of intriguing spicy and balsamic notes, including aromas of black pepper, sage and aromatic herbs. The wine is both full-bodied and vibrant in the mouth, filling the palate with its dense and elegant tannic texture and ending with a persistent and beautifully crisp finish.</p>	Bolgheri, Italy	376
<p>Tenuta San Guido Sassicaia 2020 Sassicaia means 'place of many stones', referring to the region's gravel soil. A combination of Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc, the 2020 vintage is typical of Sassicaia in which the structure never dominates the elegance and flavor of the wine. The bouquet is especially intriguing with a very lively plummy fruit element that is enhanced by baker's chocolate, pepper spice, caramel, and pie crust.</p>	Bolgheri, Italy	295
<p>Penfolds Grange 2014 The original and most powerful expression of Penfolds Australia, Grange clearly demonstrates the synergy between Shiraz and the soil and climate of South Australia. Officially listed as a Heritage Icon of South Australia, this wine is recognized as one of the best of the world's great wines.</p>	South Australia	989
<p>Vega Sicilia 'Unico' 2009 Aged for more than 10 years, Unico is the most iconic of all Spanish wines. Rich yet vibrant, dense yet graceful. Cherry and plum flavors are backed by forest floor, cedar, tobacco and mineral notes, supported by muscular, well-integrated tannins that give way to a spicy finish.</p>	Ribera del Duero, Spain	790
